○ Pat sat on a mat.

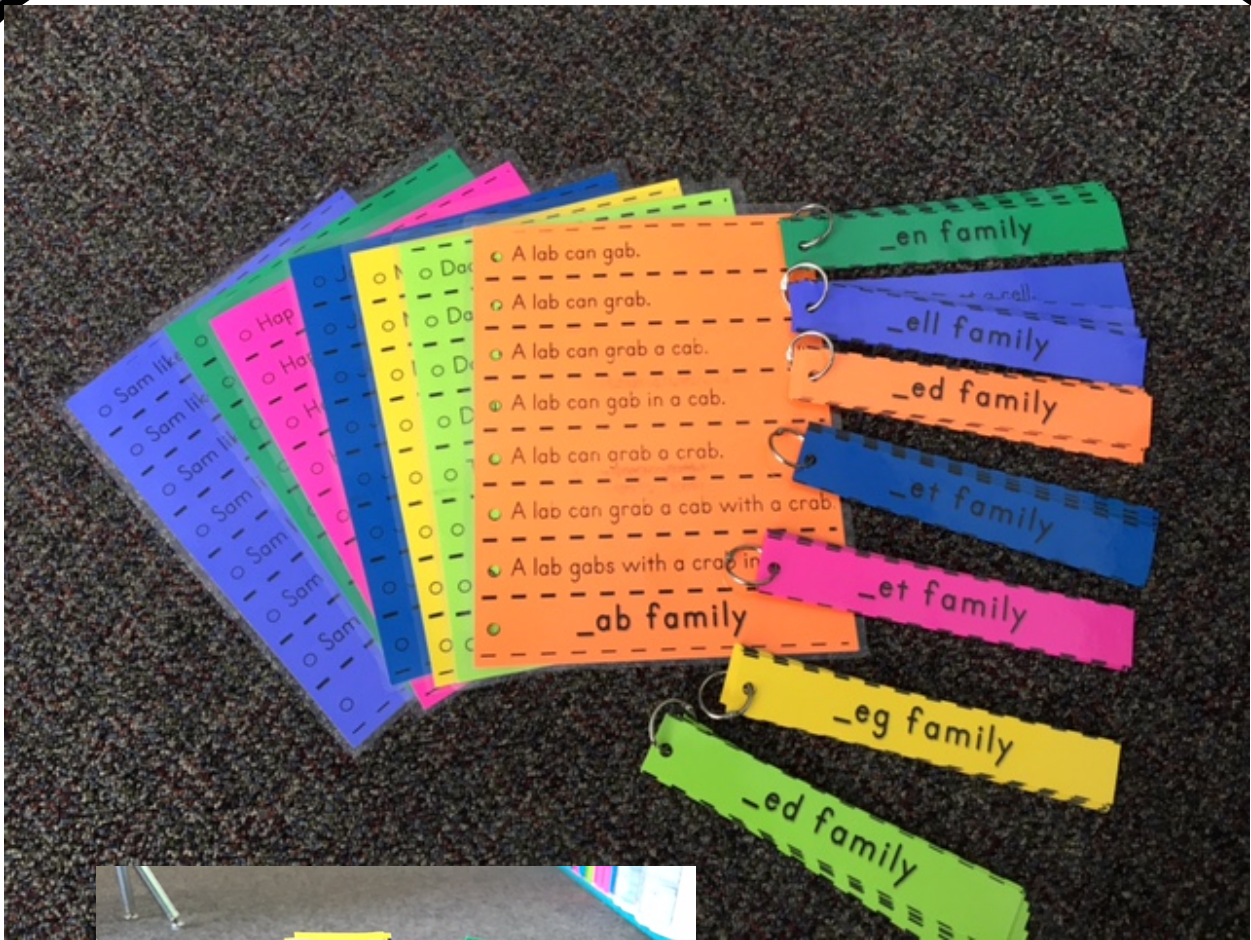
○ Pat can see a fat rat.
