

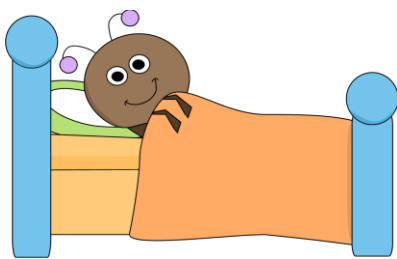

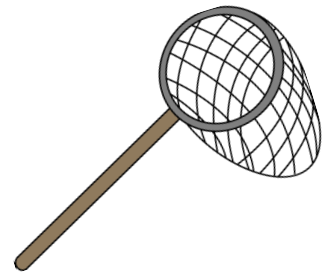

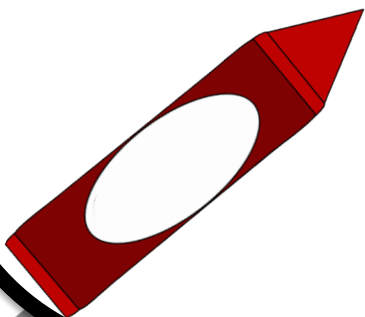
Short e vowel word families sentences.

○ I let my pet get wet.

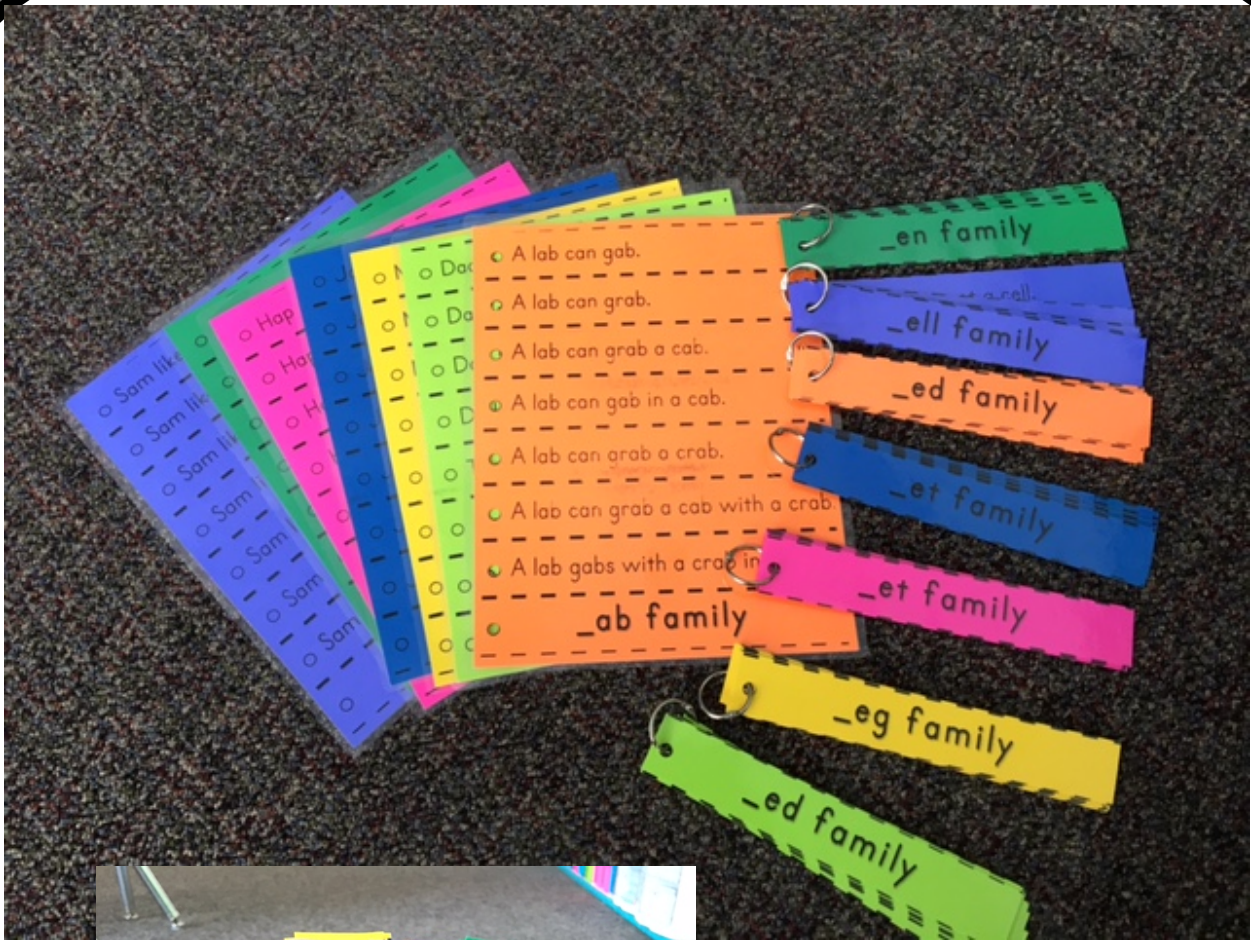
○ My pet can fret.
